Public Advisory October 6, 2022

- The RMI Safe Travels Program (STP) officially closed on Thursday 8th September, 2022
- RMI Borders have been open since and travelers no longer need to register for entry

YOU DO NOT NEED ANY TYPE OF TESTING BEFORE YOUR FLIGHT TO THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

In addition, travelers are no longer required to undergo COVID-19 testing upon arrival at any Marshall Islands airport

THE BOOSTER SHOT REQUIREMENT HAS BEEN ELIMINATED

Therefore, travelers no longer need to be boosted in order to enter the Marshall Islands

**ONLY ADULTS
18+ MUST BE
FULLY
VACCINATED**

ONLY 18 YRS AND OLDER ARE REQUIRED TO BE FULLY VACCINATED IN ORDER TO ENTER THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

IMPORTANT - you cannot travel to the Marshall Islands immediately after your last dose. You need to wait at least 14 days after your last dose and then fly over

- Travelers will need to show proof of full vaccination to the airline

A traveler can be exempted from this vaccination policy if his/her physician has advised against COVID-19 vaccination. Traveler will need to submit a certificate of letter from physician to the airline

IF YOU ARE AN HIRED WORKER TRAVELING TO THE MARSHALL ISLANDS TO PROVIDE ESSENTIAL SERVICE BUT IS NOT FULLY VACCINATED AND DO NOT HAVE A PHYSICIAN'S LETTER / CERTIFICATE

UPON ARRIVAL IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

All international arrivals must wear mask while in shared public spaces for 5 days

All visitors are required to submit health declaration cards

Travelers who become symptomatic some time after arrival date, are required to get tested at a MoHHS facility.

If positive, traveler will be required to undergo home isolation for a minimum of 5 days (and up to 24 hrs after symptoms cease)
